Space is limited, and your registration will only be considered complete when SECOME receives payment in full. Delay in payment can result in losing your registration for the event. To qualify for Early Bird Special rates, attendees must submit the registration form by July 1st, and SECOME must receive full payment no later than July 15th. Payments are due upon receipt, however regular symposium payments must be received prior to October 1, 2018 to attend the event.

Symposium registration includes a networking reception on Monday evening, lunch on Tuesday and Wednesday, and Breakfast on Thursday. Lodging, additional meals, parking, and any additional costs/fees are not included in the above symposium fees. The SECOME refund policy, Form W9, and other documentation are provided on the organization's website.
